



Constitutional Amendment 2011

There are currently some significant changes proposed to the State and Territory Associations across Australia in relation to the restructure of the Australian Wound Management Association (AWMA). It is anticipated that these changes will strengthen our Associations by more closely aligning us to the national Association. This will move us towards a nationally recognized peak body for wound management and thus provide a stronger more coherent approach politically and clinically to ensure best practice in Wound Management. reflect the new name.**
